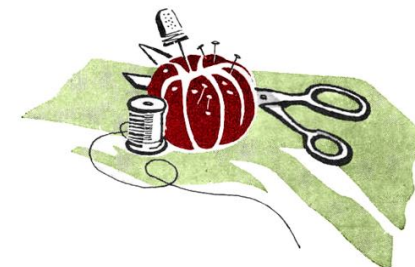
Huggate News is not currently being delivered to outlying addresses.

PARISH COUNCIL NEWS

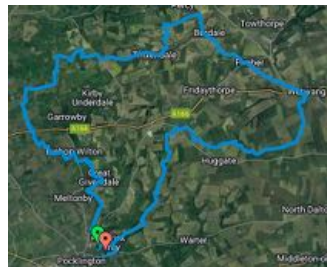

We now have two new Councillors: Vicky Knocker was elected by co-option at September's meeting and Kevin Ashurst at October's meeting.
