

St Mary's Mysterious Marks

As part of the Heritage Lottery funding for St Mary's church a number of projects are being undertaken. One is entitled "Mysterious Marks".

For anyone who likes a challenge - there are quite a number of marks, known as apotropaic or protection marks. They take the form of symbols, initials etc. embossed in the



fabric of the church, both inside and out. Mainly found on the stonework these marks have been added over centuries and take many forms.

We are looking for help finding these! Inside the church on the side aisle as you enter there are plans of the church. On these we would like you to make note of any marks you discover which haven't already been identified

There is guidance on how to do this but a torch would be handy.

Please do not touch the marks or attempt to etch them.

The stone work in places is very fragile and likely to crumble.

We are looking to record, preserve and make sense of these marks.

*Please do not climb or put yourself or anyone else in a dangerous position attempting to locate these marks.
