Now you can take on the challenging 43 mile circular trail of The Wold Rangers Way or one of the shorter ‘Trods’ with Croom Mabel (2.5 miles), Horse Hair Jack (9 miles), Ginger Joe (13 miles), Dog Geordie (17 miles) or Mad Halifax (22 miles).

All Trods start and finish in Driffield, the Capital of the Wolds.”
