- 1. Apologies were received from Kevin Ashurst holiday
- 2. Sophia Hobson was co-opted onto the Parish Council; she was nominated by Clive and seconded by Claire
- 3. Minutes from the Council meeting on 21st February were approved; all required actions have been completed
- 4. There were no declarations of interest in respect of any agenda item
- 5. Matters Arising: Parishioner had expressed concern re planning requirements being adhered to which was reported to ERYC, response will be shared with parishioner
- 6. Finance Abby confirmed the bank balance, the following payments were agreed:
 - a. clerk for 20 hours in January and February
 - b. £52 to HMRC for clerk's tax
 - c. £48 to Clive for tyre paint
 - d. £142.44 to clerk for stationery and petrol expenses from Apr 22 Mar 23
- 7. It was agreed that Claire Clayphan will be approached again to be the Independent Auditor
- 8. Abby explained the nomination and election process and nomination forms were completed
- 9. Planning
 - a. 23/00543/PLF Eastlands, The Green, Silver Street Huggate, Mr Nick Bendell, Erection of a detached building for vehicle workshop and store, received 8.3.23 response was agreed to support
- 10. Village maintenance / issues:
 - a. ERYC walkabout arranged for 31.7.23 9:45am
 - b. Knocked over salt bin agreed that no further action is needed
 - c. Roadworks signage from burnt out car on Driffield Road to be removed reported to Highways 1.3.23, confirmation received that is has been logged awaiting for this to be actioned
 - d. It is believed that other parishes within East Riding will be installing white fences at village entrances will continue to be monitored as this hasn't been permitted in the past
 - e. Dark Skies Status Abby explained that it was a lengthy complicated process and it was agreed that no further action would be taken
 - f. Potholes near Sudabys will be reported to ERYC
