Thank you to everyone who helped pick up **litter** in and around the village last month, it really makes a big difference!

The Parish Council is going to purchase a **marquee** that can be used for village / church events and we will also give residents the opportunity to borrow this is they are having a private party. Hopefully you will agree that this will be a welcome addition for the village.

We have been successful with our latest **grant application** and have been awarded £456 from the King's Coronation Community Fund which will be used for the village's Coronation Events in May.
