PARISH COUNCIL NEWS

The **equipment on the green** has been inspected by ROSPA (the Royal Society for Prevention of Accidents) to ensure its safety. This is an annual occurrence and the minor issues identified are being resolved. The **renovated bench** will be returned by the end of the month and initially placed in the churchyard for security until a permanent site is identified. The cost of the renovation has been covered by a donation from Ultra Trails. This organisation runs local long distance running events and uses the church as a check point.

Leo Hammond (Deputy Police Commissioner and Ward Councillor) has offered to come to the village during the day, to meet and discuss **speeding** with councillors and interested residents. Once the date is arranged it will be publicised on the Information WhatsApp group. Please try to come along if you are concerned about speeding.

You may be interested to know that Humberside Police allows you to submit video evidence of driving offences. **Operation Snap** is an online portal with the purpose to improve road safety and to prosecute those that put others at risk.
