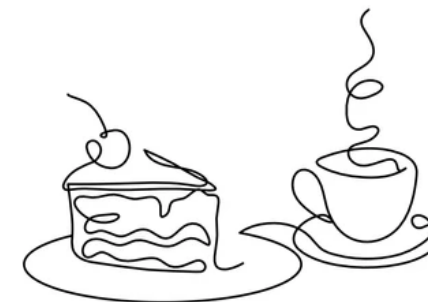

PARISH COUNCIL NEWS

Following the Village Walkabout a new litter bin has been installed on the village green to replace the damaged one.

The Bus shelter Artwork project is progressing and will be placed in the centre of the back wall of the shelter.

There is an East Riding of Yorkshire Enhanced Bus Partnership Annual Forum Event on 13th October 9:30 – 13:30 at Bishop Burton College. Places are limited but if you wish to find out more information or book a place please do so before 29th September by emailing public.transport@eastriding.gov.uk

There is a planned road closure on 24th October to enable tree trimming/felling from the overhead electricity supply network. Part of Silver Street (starting at Church Street until Silver Street Footpath to Town Farm) will be closed and the diversion route will be signed at the time of closure. Access will be maintained for emergency vehicles, residents and pedestrians.

National Heritage Lottery Grant progress

Thank you to everyone who came to the launch event and found out about the Heritage Projects and the re-ordering of the church. The children have been busy finding the **Mysterious Marks** in the church stonework, but more help is needed so please contact Ruth Braithwaite (288422) if you would like to help.

An **Ecology Survey** has been carried out at church and the 3 species of bats have been found roosting in church, Common Pipistrelle, Soprano Pipistrelle and Long Eared Brown Bat. Information about the bats can be found in church if you want to find out more.

We will not need a Bat Licence for the work in church as the re-ordering affects the ground level only.

In October a water pipe will be laid down the churchyard from the boundary for water to the south side of the church. Yorkshire Water will also connect the church to the mains water. Additional drainage to the church will be constructed with a soakaway to the north side

of the church. Throughout the re-ordering work archaeologists will keep a watching brief over the work to check on any significant finds.

The internal work will go out to tender by the end of the month, but there is some **significant work that we will be able to do ourselves with the help of villagers, removing the pews, pew platforms, floor tiles and the existing heating pipes.
