A parishioner raised the issue with Councillor Hammond at ERYC and in order to strengthen the case, it would be useful if we could have names and addresses of people who would be interested in this new bus route. Through the <u>Queen's Canopy Scheme</u>, the Parish Council obtained 30 small saplings to plant around the village. We have planted 24 of these on the Green near the second pond and in the car park; the remaining 6 were donated to a resident to plant in their garden.

May we take this opportunity to wish you all a very Merry Christmas and a Happy New Year, thank you to everyone for their support over the past year!


