There is now a seasonal **bus service at weekends.** The 200 runs on Saturdays from Pocklington to Thixendale via Millington, Huggate and Fridaythorpe stopping at Huggate at 10:40, 14:00 and 16:00. It returns at 11:25, 14:50 and 16:50. On Sundays it stops at Huggate at 11:50 and 15:50 and returns at 12:35 and 16:35. Bus passes are accepted. It will be an opportunity to maybe complete a linear walk or visit Pocklington or a neighbouring village. 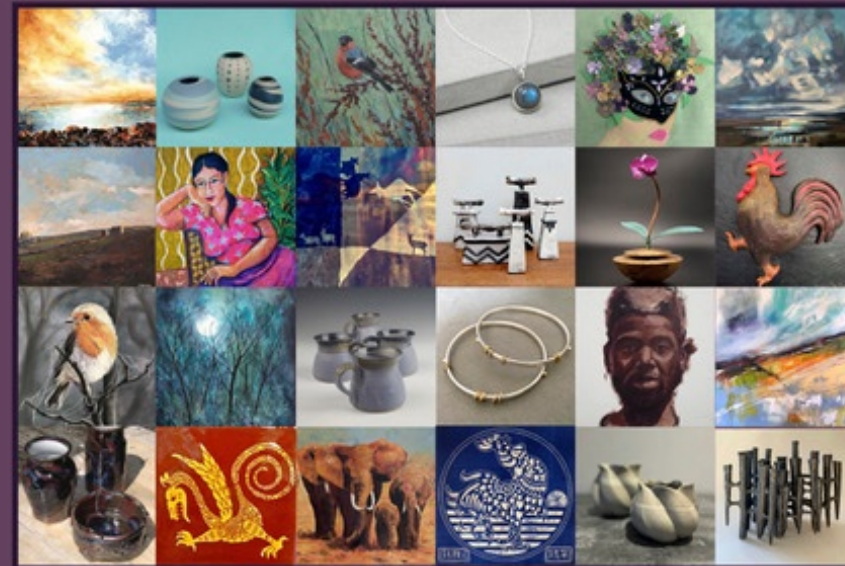
