

MINUTES OF HUGGATE PARISH COUNCIL MEETING

Emma Waslin attended before the meeting to explain her idea of creating a welcome pack for newcomers or holiday makers to the village, the Parish Council supported this idea and confirmed they were happy for their personal details to be included.

1. Apologies were received from Phil Duggleby due to work reasons and Stewart Middleton due to personal reasons.
2. Jane Thorpe was co-opted onto the Parish Council; Clare Myers nominated her and Jane Leaver seconded this.
3. The minutes of the Council meeting held on 18th May were approved and signed.
4. Jane Leaver declared an interest in item 8 c) as this relates to her work place and home, the application is from her mother.
5. Matters arising: planning application notification was added to the agenda 8. e) as this was received after the agenda had been published; Clive had distributed the follow-up actions from the ERYC walkabout – additional village maintenance ideas and feedback were discussed and appropriate actions agreed e.g. tyre planter upkeep and watering; Abby will contact Wayne Goodwin to check if the Speedwatch training can still go ahead on 7th July; the accounts have been submitted to the accountant.
6. All required actions have been completed and will be discussed within agenda.
7. Finance – Abby confirmed the bank balance
The following payments (a-e) were agreed and cheques signed:
 - a. payment to clerk for 17 hours for May 2021
 - b. payment of £41 to HMRC for clerk's tax for May 2021
 - c. payment of £19.19 to clerk for renewal of Huggate Website domain name
 - d. payment of £10 to Helen Bowman for Speedwatch training room hire
 - e. payment of £86.40 to clerk for website domain hosting renewal to WIX.com
 - f. Abby confirmed that £6437.79 had been deposited from the Nationwide inclosure fund on 11.6.21 – confirmed in a phonecall to Natwest
8. Planning
 - a) 21/00557/PLF 26.5.21 The Old Barn, Driffield Road - garage extension, permission granted - noted
 - b) 21/ 01589/PLF application received 26.5.21 Erection of agricultural storage buildings, Wold House Farm York Lane – agreed to support application
 - c) 21/01460/VAR application received 26.5.21 Wolds Inn Driffield Road, Variation of Condition 5 (Foul and Surface Water) and Condition 14 (Approved Plans) of Planning Permission 12/03897/PLF (Erection of 1 lodge for temporary residential use, 1 lodge for holiday use, creation of overflow car park) to allow installation of a septic tank and amendment to the orientation of Lodge A (Residential Lodge) by 90 degrees (Retrospective Application) – agreed to support application (Jane Leaver wasn't present for this discussion)



- d) 21/01143/PLF application received 2.6.21 Land And Buildings South Of Chestnut Lodge Driffield Road, Construction of an all-weather equestrian arena including installation of six directional LED lights on 6m high columns – agreed to support application providing 9pm limit and personal use only was adhered to
 - e) 21/04161/PLF Land north of Driffield road, erection of general purpose agriculture building and stables - permission granted - noted
9. Future Events – It was decided that the village meeting should be delayed until Tuesday 27th July due to current covid restrictions not being lifted; next litter pick will be 4th September, 10am – 12 noon starting on the Green.
