These schemes maybe of interest to you or someone you know.

MiBus service is a transport service for people who are unable to access existing bus services. There is a service on Thursdays between Driffield and York which comes to Huggate on request. To book call the booking team on 03456 445959.

If anyone needs some assistance with transport to attend a medical appointment the Medibus service may be able to help. They provide a friendly, door to door, accessible transport solution. This operates on a pre-booked, first come, first served basis. All you need to do is contact the dedicated Passenger Services Call Centre on 03456 445959 to check seat availability or email passengerbookings@eastriding.gov.uk. Information is displayed on the Village noticeboard.

The price cap on standard bus fares throughout England is being extended until November 2024 and is set at £2.50 per journey from 1st November.
