It also looks like the Speedwatch training will be postponed too until later in July, those who volunteered to take part will be informed of a new date when this has been arranged.

The next **Lucinda's Litterpick** will be on **Saturday 4<sup>th</sup> September** – slightly longer this time from 10am – 12 noon so that we can go further afield to collect more litter on the outskirts of the village. Please meet at the Green.

Thank you to Councillors Adrian Brader and Stewart Middleton who kindly gave up their time to clear the grass from the concrete tank pads on the way to Warter. A villager had pointed out that the overgrown grass / moss was preventing cars being able to park, this has now been rectified allowing more cars to use this space rather than parking in the village.

Jane Thorpe was co-opted onto the Parish Council last month and was warmly welcomed to the group, we still have one more vacancy if anyone is interested in joining.
