A massive thank you to everyone who came to the **Annual Village Meeting**. It was a record turnout and much appreciated.

Thank you to everyone who completed the **questionnaire**. All your responses and comments will be considered carefully and used to plan for the future. **If you haven't sent one in yet, there is still time for a paper copy to be left at the Wolds Inn.**

The **Autospeed watch camera** and signs will be installed by ERYC week beginning 1st June. The camera will operate 24 hours every day and offences will be reported to the police. The camera is designed to replace Speedwatch volunteers.

Additional signage and bag dispensers are being placed in an attempt to stop the **dog poo** around the village. The ERYC dog warden should be contacted if you know the name of any dog owner not picking up. Phone number 01482 393939 and ask for the dog warden.

**SCRAPSTORE** - voluntary donation to help yourself to left over scraps suitable for crafting and other projects or donate any that you no longer need.

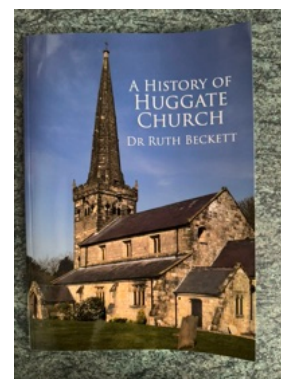
